### **Social Distance Practices:**

Together, we can slow the spread of COVID-19 by making a conscious effort to keep a physical distance between each other. Physical distancing is proven to be one of the most effective ways to reduce the spread of illness during an outbreak. With patience and cooperation, we can all do our part.

This means making changes in your everyday routines to minimize close contact with others, including:

- Avoiding crowded places and gatherings
- Avoiding common greetings, such as handshakes
- Limiting contact with people at higher risk (e.g. older adults and those in poor health)
- Keeping a distance of at least 2 arms lengths (approximately 2 metres) from others, as much as possible

### Description

Using an online form, volunteers Write a Note of encouragement choosing the recipient from a drop down menu including: student, senior, family or teacher. A simple act of local love providing encouragement to those that need it most.

## DIY GUIDE TO ENCOURAGE-MINT BUILD

### Description

Everyone can use a bit of encouragement. Completed encourage-MINTs will be included in other kits, distributed at meal programs to show your local love and to let recipients know someone cares.

### Supplies

- 3in X 5in Flat Clear Plastic Bags (Gale's)
- 2in X 4in Shipping Labels
- Printer
- Mints (individually wrapped)



### Directions

- Design and print your encouragement label. See photo included as an example. Consider your audience when creating this content.
- In each clear plastic bag, place a few individually wrapped mints.
- If your plastic bag does not have an adhesive edge, fold end over and use the shipping label to seal.

## DIY COMFORT KIT BUILD

### Description

Comfort Kits are designed to provide just that: comfort. Regardless of the situation, be it an isolated senior, a client at a domestic violence shelter or a struggling teen it's comforting to know someone out there cares for you and wants the best for you. These kits can be a compilation of items or focus on a larger item like a no-sew blanket.

### Supplies

- no-sew blanket (fabric, scissors, ruler)
- hygiene items (nail clipper, shampoo etc.)
- mints
- lotion
- socks
- word search, deck of cards
- journal

### Directions

- Collect items and place in a bag for delivery.
- All items must be new/unused
- Get creative and write an encouragement note with your own personal greeting. Example 'Someone thought of you today' or 'You are strong'
- Take a picture of completed kit and tag @UnitedWayRegina on Instagram, Facebook or Twitter.

### Instructions

- Choose fleece fabric. You will need two pieces of fabric the same size. Can be contrasting patterns or can be made of the same material.
- Line up the two fabrics, right sides OUT. Anti-pill solids are FUZZY on the right side. Anti-pill prints will be more vibrant on the front side. Regular prints are hard to tell -- use the side that appeals to you.
- Trim the two pieces so that they are the same size.
- Cut a 5-inch square from each of the four corners. Discard cut-outs.
- Cut fringe on all four sides of the blanket. Cut through both layers of fabric at the same time. Fringe pieces should be a little wider than the width of your finger. Cut in from the edge 5 inches.
- Leave your blanket laying flat on the surface, with all fringes lined up. Tie knots. There are a variety of ways to tie knots including balloon knots, tie them just like you would if tying off a balloon! See video for more techniques.
- Tie all the fringes together on all four sides of the blanket. You are Finished!
- Adult: 2 yards of each fabric Child: 1.5 yards of each fabric Baby: 1 yard of each

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
## DIY GUIDE TO READINESS KIT BUILD

### Description

Kindergarten Readiness Kits are filled with supplies that assist parents/caregivers in preparing their child for school using everyday experiences and turning them into learning opportunities. Children develop early learning skills including fine motor skill development. You can help ensure all children have activities and resources necessary to help prepare them for success in school and in life. Kits can include a variety of the supplies listed below.

### Supplies

- board book(s)
- Kids scissors
- Glue stick (1)
- Pencil Crayons (1 box)
- Markers (1 box)
- Pencils (10)
- magnetic letters  
upper and lower case
- flash cards
- sketch pad
- play-doh
- construction paper



### Directions

- Collect items and place inside the pencil box/case.
- All items must be new/unused
- Get creative and write an encouragement note with your own personal greeting. Example 'Have fun learning'

- All items must be new/unused
- Get creative and write an encouragement note with your own personal greeting. Example 'Thinking of you'

- Baby Shampoo
- Child size socks
- Childrens toothbrush/toothpaste
- Ziploc bag - 1)package

- Collect items in large/x-large plastic Ziploc bags
- All items must be new/unused
- Get creative and write an encouragement note with your own personal greeting. Example 'Thinking of you'

### **Supplies**

- Diapers
- Baby wipes
- Thermometer
- Baby blanket
- Baby bath wash
- Baby shampoo
- Nail scissors/nail clippers/nail file set
- Baby bag

### **Directions**

- Collect items in the baby bag
- All items must be new/ unused
- Write an encouragement note to the mother. Example 'Congratulations' or 'Thinking of You.'
