

Summer Success Initiative:

Since 2015, the Summer Success Initiative has helped kids at risk of summer learning loss maintain or improve their literacy skills. In collaboration with Public and Catholic School Divisions, the initiative offers a two-week literacy camp staffed by professional teachers. It is designed to help those students who are one or more grade-levels below where they should be, to avoid falling even further behind over the summer.
