\$10/month

Provides children with 12 books per year to start their own at home library. We know education is key to addressing poverty. In Regina, 45% of students enter kindergarten not knowing letters or numbers.

Provides a child with access to at least one nutritional meal every day for a month. In Saskatchewan, children under the age of 17 account for more than 40% of those facing food insecurity in their own homes.
