211 is a free, confidential service that connects individuals to human services in the province by telephone, text, or on-line chat, plus a searchable website with over 6,000 listings of community, government and health services across the province.

This access to community, non-emergency health and government services is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year. Over 175 languages, including 17 Indigenous languages, are available over the phone.
